He raised concerns from the PPG, particularly to do with the phone system, and Helen explained the affect the survey had on the staff which had led to a number of meetings on the responses and, following it, a number of resignations.

He said the PPG meetings would continue on Zoom when use of the Tollgate surgery, and its meeting room, returned to normal use,.

6 Practice Report:

Staff

- We have a new Reception Supervisor starting with us on 16th Aug, Sally Smith, she has been in primary care for 6 years
- We also have a new secretary starting with us on 25th Aug, Sophie Saville
- Janet Belton, Healthcare Assistant is leaving us 27th August
- We have a prescription clerk and receptionist both leaving end of August
- Adverts are out for HCA, Prescription Clerk, 2 x Receptionist, and an additional Secretary
- 13 Receptionists currently in post
- The last month has been the toughest to date with staff due to isolation, sickness and annual leave

Covid vaccine

- Vaccinated 98.4% of our eligible patients in cohort 1-9
- 261 left to vaccinate in the practice in total in cohort 1-9
- 10,080 patients have had 2nd vaccine in cohort 1-12
- 1243 patients left to vaccinate in cohorts 10-12
- Will soon be offering vaccination to cohort 13 for ages 12-17

Other

- Flu clinic dates to be announced next week but will be going ahead mid Sept, appointments can be booked via a link sent through SMS
- The week 9th 13th August, Ambrose will be shutting its door every day from 1.30pm due to staff shortages
- We are trying very hard to find ways to ease pressure on the phones. However we are noticing a number of phone calls received to the practice are queries that can be dealt with in the community pharmacies, NHS England, Ambrose Website.

6 Practice Activity: The July report was circulated. Members asked that a patient review of report headings should be added to the September PPG agenda, with the intention of suggesting changes which could possible lead to the figures being more informative for patients.

7 Members' Discussion: Debate on the reports raised queries on:

- Concerns that the reduction in reception staff and closing of the surgeries would lead to even more pressure on the phone system which many patients are already dissatisfied with.
- The general consensus was that tweaks to the present operation had achieved adequate results and that total replacement of the system should be considered.
- Roly and Ray were asked to draw up a letter to the GP Partners ourtlining the PPG concerns and suggesting remedial action.

8 Facebook update

Kevin submitted the report on Facebook activity Membership had risen to 578, up by 35. The peak engagement was over posts about temporary closures and restrictions which reached some 2,000 views.
